



2016-17 EUROPEAN ZONE USBC PEPSI YOUTH BOWLING CHAMPIONSHIPS **Bowler Instructions**

(ATHLETES MUST SEE THESE RULES)

1. The European Zone Youth Championships is certified by the United States Bowling Congress (USBC) under sanction #**04353** for the Regional Tournament and under sanction #**04354** for the EuroZone Final competition. This championship is governed by USBC rules, and hosted by the European Zone Tournament Committee.

2. Competition is open to all registered 2016-2017 USBC Youth members. To compete, a bowler must be a regular member of a certified USBC league and not be under suspension. League substitutes are allowed to participate if it is their only USBC Youth league. USBC Collegiate members are eligible if they are 2016-2017 USBC Youth members, bowl in a USBC Youth league and have not violated USBC Rule 400. **Regional Level Competition will be held on 25 February 2017 at the Liberty Lanes in Lakenheath, United Kingdom (UK) and the Vogelweh Bowling Center in Kaiserslautern, Germany (GE).** Those houses outside of either the UK or GE can select whichever location they wish to participate at. **The Zone Level Competition will be held on 25-26 March 2017 at the Eifel Lanes Bowling Center in Spangdahlem, Germany.**

3. All USBC Youth members in good standing are eligible for this competition. There will be **NO League Level Qualification Round**. Bowling centers having 2016-2017 USBC certified youth leagues are automatically league level qualified sites and there is a **one-to-one ratio directly to the next level.**

4. Competition will be conducted in 12 divisions based on the participant's age as outlined below. Participation in the wrong age division will lead to automatic disqualification. Bowlers must stay in the given division in that particular league throughout the entire window:

A. To Regional Level Competition:

- ➔ U06 Boys - Girls Bowlers whose birth date is 1Aug10 or later
- ➔ U08 Boys - Girls Bowlers whose birth date is 1Aug08 thru 31Jul10
- ➔ U10 Boys - Girls Bowlers whose birth date is 1Aug06 thru 31Jul08
- ➔ U12 Boys - Girls Bowlers whose birth date is 1Aug04 thru 31Jul06

B. To Zone Level Competition:

- ➔ U12 Boys - Girls Top 25% from Regional (if they want to participate)
- ➔ U15 Boys - Girls Bowlers whose birth date is 1Aug01 thru 31Jul04

→ U20 Boys - Girls Bowlers whose birth date is 1Aug96 thru 31Jul01
ALL PEPSI EVENTS WILL BE CONDUCTED ON A SCRATCH BASIS ONLY

***Athletes are not mandated to be USBC Junior Gold members to enter the U15 and U20 Divisions or the U12 Zone Level Competition.**

5. Entry fees for the European Zone Championships (Regional and Final) are as follows
*(Please note entry fees are **NON-REFUNDABLE**):*

6. Scholarship fees will be returned 100% to the athlete. Scholarship funds will be forwarded and maintained in the SMART Program at USBC, the contact information is as follows: toll free 1-800-514-2695 (extension 8292). **SMART Account Number is 8557**. Scholarships will be awarded to the **top 25%** within each division.

7. Symbolic special awards will be awarded for High Scores from the entire tournament and given as follows:

NOTE: The same bowler will not receive both special awards. High Series will have precedence.

8. Participants can attempt to qualify in any state/zone where they hold a 2016-2017 USBC Youth membership card. However, the bowler can only advance once using the following criteria:

- A. Advancers out of league level must remain in the division they qualified in during all subsequent levels.
- B. If a bowler qualifies in different leagues from multiple divisions, the bowler must select one division they will compete in before subsequent competition.
- C. If the bowler advances out of league level in more than one state/zone, the bowler **must** declare one state/zone to continue competing in before the next competition level.

D. Bowlers must declare within each league if they chose to "opt up" to a higher age division. All bowlers that choose to "opt up" must complete a **WAIVER FORM** prior to the competition.

E. Bowlers will remain in the division they qualified in during the league level in all subsequent competition. Participation in the wrong age division will lead to automatic disqualification.

F. Junior Gold members who have already earned an entry in the 2016-17 Junior Gold Championships can still enter and participate in additional Junior Gold qualifying events. **However, because an athlete can only earn one entry into the Junior Gold Championships he/she must accept his/her first berth.**

9. The tournament format shall be as follows:

All Athletes will be allowed 10 minutes of practice on their starting lanes. In case of lane breakdown during practice athletes will be allowed to finish their 10 minutes of practice. If lane breakdown occurs during competition there will be 2 practice balls per lane authorized. Athletes arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame being bowled. Missed frames will not be made up and shall be credited with a zero. An athlete not present to bowl when it is their turn will be credited with a zero for that frame.

A. Regional Level Competition (UK and GE):

- 1) U6 Divisions will bowl two (2) games on one pair of lanes.
- 2) U8, U10, and U12 Divisions will bowl three (3) games on one pair of lanes.

B. Zone Level Competition:

- 1) U12 Division finalists that wish to compete will bowl four (4) games on only one day. They will not change lanes but will bowl all games on the same pair of lanes.
- 2) U15 and U20 Divisions will bowl five (5) games each day for two days. A total of 10 games will be bowled, and bowlers will move one pair of lanes to the right after each game.
- 3) Ties for the first qualifying position will result in a one-game roll-off.

C. Side Tournaments: All these tournaments are open to any USBC sanctioned youth and there is **NO** dress code for these tournaments.

1) Adult/Youth Scotch Doubles. This tournament will be held after the Regional Level Competition at both the Vogelweh Bowling Center and the Liberty Lanes. Price for this event is \$30.00 per team and all proceeds will be distributed to the youth in the form of SMART scholarship as a ratio of 1:5. The oil pattern used will be a regular house pattern.

2) 9-Pin No-Tap Ice Breaker. This tournament will be held on the Friday evening before the Zone Level Competition at the Eifel Lanes. The cost is \$25 per individual for a three (3) game series. All proceeds will be distributed to the youth in the form of SMART scholarship at a ratio of 1:5. The oil pattern for this event will be used on the lanes Saturday.

3) Adult/Youth Baker Style Tournament. This tournament will be held on Saturday evening after the first day of bowling at the Zone Level Competition. The cost is \$45 for the team of one (1) adult and two (2) youth bowlers. All proceeds from this tournament will be distributed in the form of SMART scholarships to the youth in the final 5 teams. The oil pattern for this event will be used on the lanes Sunday.

10. The established **Dress Code** must be strictly adhered to during competition as well as **during awards presentations**. The dress code shall be as follows:

A. Athletes must wear a collared shirt (plain t-shirts are not acceptable) or the USBC or League Youth Jersey. All shirts must have finished sleeves for all competition. Only full-length pants/slacks that cover the stomach area, and must also be belted at the waist will be allowed for all males and females during all competition. Females may also wear skirts, culottes, skorts, or walking shorts that are no shorter than the fingertips when the arms are at their sides while standing. All apparel worn by bowlers shall be loose fitting and **NOT made of denim, fleece or Lycra/spandex-like material. NO jeans of any color, bib overalls, yoga pants, Capri pants, scooters, warm-up suits or clothes with elastic at the ankles will be allowed.**

B. Apparel must be in good repair (no holes, tears, frays, etc) and must not display any obscene gestures, profanity, tobacco/alcohol advertisements, or graphic/offensive material. No writing on or defacing of the bowling shirts will be permitted at any time.

C. No head covering or sunglasses can be worn during competition (hats, caps or bandanas).

D. No cell phones, headphones or electronics of any kind can be used in the bowlers' area during competition.

E. **Only the U6, U8, U10, and U12 bowlers during "REGIONAL" competition are allowed to wear jeans.**

11. Only athletes, tournament officials and scorekeepers will be allowed in the settee area. Displays of unsportsmanlike conduct by athletes will be basis for disqualification. Unsportsmanlike conduct by any spectator will result in the removal of that spectator from the bowling center. Parents are asked to refrain from being overzealous during the youth competition.

12. Smoking and drinking is not authorized by competitors during tournament competition at any time (before/during/after competition play), within or around the Bowling Centers. Parents and guests are permitted to smoke outside the bowling centers, but **no one can drink alcohol during competition**

13. The top one (1) bowler in the U12, U15 and U20 divisions from both Boys and Girls at the European Zone Pepsi Youth Championships Final competition with the highest scratch score (total cumulative pin fall for all games, with the exception of tie breaking games, bowled by the athlete during the competition) will earn a berth to the Junior Gold Championships to be held **15-22 July 2017 in Cleveland, Ohio**. The six bowlers are not required be a Junior Gold Program member at the European Zone Pepsi Youth Championships. However, to receive the berth, the bowler must be a Junior Gold program member or be eligible for membership (all USBC Youth Standard Members are eligible) and obtain membership prior to the championships. Junior Gold Membership application must be submitted at the close of this tournament. All winners are responsible for completing registration requirements located on the USBC Junior Gold Tournament web-site (<http://www.bowl.com/>).

If the winner is not willing to purchase USBC Junior Gold Membership for the championships, he/she will still retain all awards from the European Zone Youth Championships, but the next eligible bowler will receive the berth to the Junior Gold Championships. This also applies if the winner already has a berth for the Junior Gold Championships from a prior tournament.

14. Eligible advancers **must agree** to bowl in the Junior Gold Championships and provide flight confirmation NLT 31 May 2017, or failing to do so, agree to waive all rights to attend the championships and will refund any ancillary funding provided for travel to the championships. The designated alternate replacement from their division at the zone level will attend and must therefore also be a Junior Gold program member. The replacement will incur all costs associated with travel arrangements.

15. Failure to abide by any rules and regulations will lead to disqualification from this event. The USBC Youth Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any participant.

16. The European Zone Tournament Committee in conjunction with the USBC Pepsi Youth Championships National Tournament Committee will decide all matters not covered by these rules and regulations, or USBC rules and regulations. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament committee immediately upon detection. The

tournament committee shall decide upon questionable errors. **All other protests must be submitted in writing to the tournament director before the awards are presented.** Under this rule, each protest must be specific in itself. The tournament will not be delayed if at all possible.
