

Adult/Youth Scotch Doubles Tournament

TEAMS: Teams will consist of 2 participants: One participant must be a USBC sanctioned youth athlete. The remaining participant must be an adult, over the age of 18, who is not a USBC certified youth bowler. A minimum of 12 teams is required in order to hold the tournament. A maximum of 64 teams will be accepted. Ideally, the line up will consist of two divisions with regard to the age of the youth athlete: U6/U8/U10/U12 and U15/U20. During the initial tournament registration, only 32 teams per age division will be accepted, any remaining teams will be placed on a waiting list. If 30 minutes prior to the start of the tournament, a division is not filled, remaining positions will be filled from the waiting list regardless of division. A minimum of 10 teams in each division is required in order to host two separate divisions, otherwise the tournament will be hosted as a single division event. There is no dress code for this tournament.

DATE: The tournament will take place on Saturday, [25 February 2017](#), at approximately 1500, at Vogelweh Bowling Center and Liberty Lanes Center. Registration will commence at approximately 1300 (or two hours prior to the projected start time of the tournament). Please note this time may be different than that listed on the schedule of events due to delays in the European Zone Regional Tournament competition.

ENTRY FEE: \$30 per team. Entry fee must be paid in cash at the time of registration.

FORMAT: This is a Scotch Doubles format whereby the youth athlete will roll the first ball in the 1st game and the adult will pick up the spare. If the youth rolls a strike, the adult will roll the first ball of the next frame. Each team will bowl three Scotch Doubles style qualifying games. The starting bowler of the 2nd and 3rd games can be either the youth or the adult bowler. At the conclusion of three games, the top 50% of each division will advance to the next level of play. If divisions were not established, the top 50% of the overall field will advance. The number of teams advancing will be an even number. The final level of play will be a shoot out format with all teams bowling single Scotch Doubles style games, continually eliminating the two lowest scoring teams after each game, until only two teams remain. The highest Scotch Doubles score between the final two teams will be the winner. If there is a tie at any level, a 10th frame roll off, following the Scotch Doubles style, will be conducted. This is a *scratch* event. Pins will not carry over from each game.

LANE ASSIGNMENTS: Starting lanes will be randomly assigned approximately 15 minutes prior to start time. Subsequent assignments for the remainder of the tournament will be at director's discretion.

AWARDS: Awards will be in the form of SMART scholarships (youth only). All entry monies will be returned in the form of scholarship monies 100%, lineage will be paid from competition expenses. SMART scholarships will be awarded based on a ratio of 1:5 teams or fraction thereof.

9-Pin No-Tap Tournament

COMPOSITION: This is an individual competition based on total pin fall. This is open to all USBC sanctioned Youth Bowlers. There is no dress code for this tournament.

DATE: The tournament will take place on Friday, *24 March 2017*, at approximately 1830, at Eifel Lanes Bowling Center in Spangdahlem. Registration will commence at approximately 1800 at the start of the Ice Breaker.

ENTRY FEE: \$25 for all individuals. Entry fee must be paid in cash at the time of registration.

FORMAT: This is a 9-Pin No Tap Scratch Tournament consisting of one division with everyone competing against each other. If a bowler throws a 9 count on the first ball, it will count as a strike. Every entrant will bowl a three (3) game series. Winners will be based on the three (3) game total score.

LANE ASSIGNMENTS: Starting lanes will be randomly assigned approximately 15 minutes prior to start time. All three games will be bowled on the same pair of lanes.

AWARDS: Awards will be in the form of SMART scholarships. All entry monies will be returned in the form of scholarship monies 100%, lineage will be paid from competition expenses. SMART scholarships will be awarded at a 1:5 ratio or any fraction thereof.

NOTE: Oil Pattern used for this tournament will be the same one used during competition on Saturday.

Adult/Youth Baker Tournament

TEAMS: Teams will consist of 3 participants: Two participants must be USBC sanctioned youth athletes. The remaining participant must be an adult, over the age of 18, who is not a USBC certified youth bowler. A minimum of 10 teams is required in order to hold the tournament. A maximum of 28 teams will be accepted. The tournament will be hosted as a single division *scratch* event. There is no dress code for this tournament.

DATE: The tournament will take place on Saturday, **25 March 2017**, at approximately 1830, at Eifel Lanes Bowling Center in Spangdahlem. Registration will commence at approximately 1630 (or two hours prior to the projected start time of the tournament). Please note this time may be different than that listed on the schedule of events due to delays in the European Zone Tournament competition.

ENTRY FEE: \$45 per team. Entry fee must be paid in cash at the time of registration.

FORMAT: Each team will bowl three Baker Style qualifying games. At the conclusion of three games, the top 50% will advance to the next level of play. The remaining teams will bowl another two Baker Style games and the top 50% will advance again. If after this level we have the final 5 remaining teams, then we will go automatically to the seeded stepladder. If not, then the remaining teams will bowl another game to determine the top 5 teams to advance. The final level of play will be a seeded stepladder. If there is a tie at any level, a 10th frame roll off will be conducted. Pins will not carry over from each game.

LANE ASSIGNMENTS: Starting lanes will be randomly assigned approximately 15 minutes prior to start time. Subsequent assignments for the remainder of the tournament will be at director's discretion.

AWARDS: Awards will be in the form of SMART scholarships (youth only). All entry monies will be returned in the form of scholarship monies 100%, lineage will be paid from competition expenses. SMART scholarships will be awarded to the 5 teams making the stepladder finals.

NOTE: Oil Pattern used for this tournament will be the same one used during competition on Sunday.
